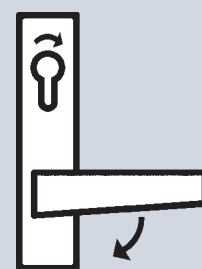

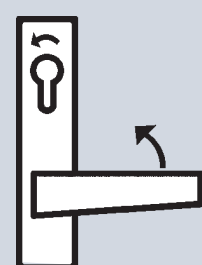
Open.



1 Give an electronic signal or turn the key a quarter towards the hinge side of the door then release the key.

2 Unlock the door by lowering the door handle.

Close.



1 Bolt the door by moving the handle up.

2 Turn the key a quarter to the lock edge of the door. To avoid any manipulation from the outside, the door handle is now blocked from the outside.

If step 2 is not performed, the Easy Exit function will be preserved. With this the escape route will be safe for those still staying in the house.

The front door versions 4917 and 4918 are equipped with the 'OneShot' function. To open the door from the outside at all times, once the door has closed, an electronic signal or key will be required to unlock the door, and then by simply pushing the handle down.

The back door versions 4927 and 4928 have a standard latch function on the latch bolt. Providing the handle is **not** moved up, the door can be opened normally, from either side.



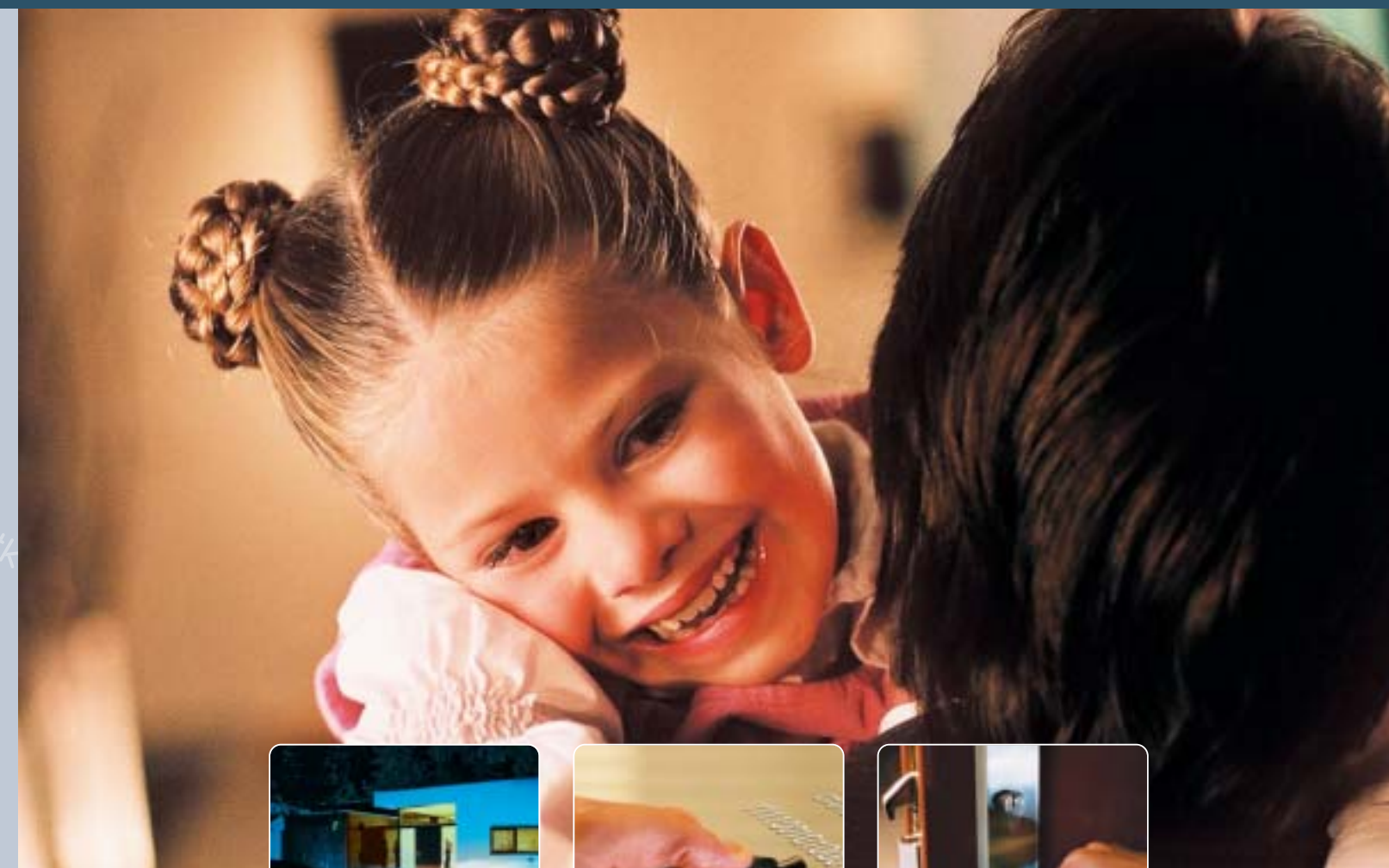
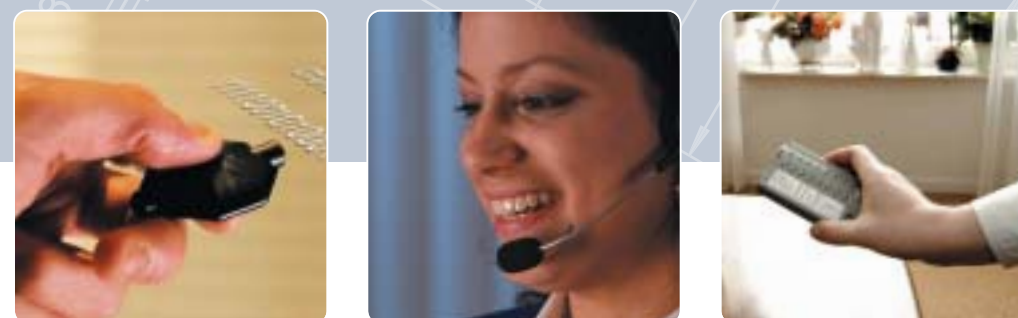

A good lock gives security and, however not by definition, comfort. Comforte® offers the solution, together with the Radaris remote control. When the door closes after entering, it cannot be opened from the outside with the lever. Oneshot. Once inside, the door can be locked easily on 3 points by pushing up the lever. The combination of a front and back door lock with a lever/lever operation and the Oneshot function is unique.



Sometimes, the opening of a front door is a tough job, especially when the key has to be turned a couple of times. Then there is the common situation when you are looking for your key with your hands full of shopping.

Comforte® is an unique lever operated multi-point locking device with an easy and compliant (adaptable) operation.

Whilst developing the Comforte®, NEMEF paid close attention to the security which a front and back door should offer. Locking on more than one point, as the Dutch police hall mark "safe living" requires, is an example of that. More than one locking point also means that more strength should be transmitted to operate the device. The key only, which is used for the transmission on traditional doors is not sufficient anymore, especially when the door closes into the frame.

The NEMEF Comforte®, together with the Radaris remote control, is already an extraordinary lock of convenience, however there are many more possibilities. The electronics used, make it possible to have the Comforte® working in conjunction with: remote control, intercom, access control systems, external communication centres, phone-in function, and social medical alarm systems.

The sophisticated combination of electronics and mechanical locking makes the Comforte especially suitable for domestic application and social medical alarm systems. Through the various possibilities of using the lock electronically, the Comforte offers convenience and safety. Radaris remote control.

It is already standard equipment in the "middle class" car: the opening and closing of the door by a remote control. NEMEF now brings the same facility close at hand for the home. Comforte® provides, in combination with Radaris, an easy and safe unlocking of the front and back door. Radaris consists of a door unit which is simple to install and a remote control.



Simplicity is the trick.

The strength and safety of Radaris lies in the simplicity of the system. After one push on the button the door can be opened for 10 seconds; after that Comforte® locks automatically again. The two penlight (AA) alkaline batteries which power the Radaris, can be used for approximately 4 years, when used normally. When the batteries need to be changed (warning by an audible peep signal), Comforte® can be operated mechanically by the key. Radaris functions without cabling and is therefore suitable for almost every door.



Access Control System SmartTag® replaces the key.

Comforte® is pre-eminently suitable in combination with the SmartTag® access control system of NEMEF. The system consists of a weatherproof in-built reader, simply programmed SmartTags and the corresponding software. By a local or internet connection with the network, it can be controlled who and when will have access to which room. By showing a SmartTag® to the reader, the Comforte® will be unlocked and the door involved can be opened. The system is also suitable for domestic applications within other access control systems.
